

Guest lecture on:

"Parent-Teacher Meet"

- 3. Strengthened Communication Channels: The PTM reinforced the importance of open communication between parents and teachers, laying the foundation for continued collaboration and partnership. Parents suggested starting a WhatsApp group of parents for daily attendance updates.
- 4. Continuous Improvement: Feedback gathered from parents will be instrumental in refining college policies, programs, and practices to better meet the needs of students and families.
- 5. Follow-up Actions: Teachers and parents agreed upon specific action points and follow-up measures to address identified concerns and monitor student progress.
- 6. New strategies: Communicating for scholarships other than government scholarships. Parents suggested starting scholarships under the youth foundation. Making helmets compulsory for students who come by their private vehicles.

The action required for the suggestions has been successfully carried out immediately. A spirit of collaboration and mutual respect prevailed throughout the meeting, fostering a positive atmosphere conducive to productive dialogue. Teachers and parents exchanged valuable perspectives, reinforcing the shared commitment to the holistic development of students.
